Teachers Feedback Report 2021-2022



This survey is done every academic year with a sample of around 188 Teachers.

The IQAC of this college took the lead in conducting the Teachers Feedback on-line in April 2022. The Feedback results were electronically tabulated and printed by IQAC for analysis and for continual improvement to processes and systems. The analysis was compiled into a survey report which was submitted to the Principal for review and approval prior to implementation of recommended improvement actions. Survey report was made available to teachers after approval and it is uploaded in the college web portal.

The Teachers survey was done online using Google forms done online using Google forms this digitized process is Green and Automatic as per the Green policy of the institution. The online mode of data collection ensures speedy acquisition of information and also prompt analysis. This sample survey which is done with a sample of 188 Teachers, will be extended to the process of Complete Enumeration in future. 






2. Aims and objectives of the syllabi are well defined and clear to teachers and students 188 responses








5. Curriculum having good academic flexibility




6. The course content fulfils the need of students












12. The environment in the college supports teaching.




13. The college provides support for skill up gradation.




14. The internet facility is good.




15. The courses reflect the needs of the society




16. Working in this college is a matter of pride.




17. Administrative support is good.




18. The College has adequate teaching Learning facilities.


19. The college has enough Parking Facilities

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

TEACHERS FEEDBACK SURVEY ANALYSIS REPORT (2021- 2022)

The feedback process is effectively used as a mechanism to identify the following:

- 1. The effectiveness of key areas should be retained and enhanced.
- 2. The opportunities for continuous improvement.

These generally revealed that students were highly satisfied with their study experiences in this sesquicentennial institution of Tamil Nadu.

STRENGTHS OF THE INSTITUTION

- 98% of staff members well versed with the vision, mission and objectives of the institution
- Around 98% of the staff members accepted that the aim and objectives of the syllabi are well defined and clear.
- More than 97% of the staff members agreed that allocations of optional courses are sufficient.
- More than 96% of the staff members agreed that the programme outcomes of the syllabi are well defined and the curriculum has enough academic flexibility.
- More than 95% of the staff members agreed that the various courses cater to the needs of the students.
- 97% of the staff members enjoyed the teaching and learning process with full freedom to adopt new techniques and strategies which increases the faculty interest too.
- 96% of the staff members felt that they have adequate opportunities and support to update their knowledge.
- 94 % of the staff members stated that they have freedom to adopt new techniques and strategies of teaching, group discussions, seminar presentations and learners participation.

- 97 % of the staff members stated that they have adequate opportunities and support for improving their skills and qualifications.
- More than 86 % of staff members felt that they have a pleasant environment and new techniques for teaching and learning, Adequate facilities for learning in terms of Library and ICT facilities.
- More than 94 % of staff members strongly accepted that the courses offered by the institution fulfill the needs of the society and industry.
 - More than 95 % of staff members felt that working in this institution is a matter of pride.
- More than 89% of staff members stated that there is enough parking facility, 94% of staff members accepted there is scope for adequate learning facilities and 90 % of staff members feel that they have good administrative support.

From this exclusive survey, around 95% of the staff members responded that they were highly satisfied with the services rendered by the College. With the implementation of the improvement actions identified in this survey, we will be expecting better results in the next Academic year 2022-2023.
