Minutes of the Exam Manual Committee meetings – 6 & 7.1.2022

The following decisions are recommended for streamlining eligibility conditions for writing semester examinations for both UG and PG Programs.

| S.No | Attendance Percentage | Category | Conditions for writing semester examinations |
|------|-----------------------|-------------------|--|
| 1. | 75% and above | Eligible | Student is permitted to appear for semester examinations without condonation of attendance. |
| 2. | 65% to 74% | Condonation | Student is permitted to appear for semester examinations after paying the prescribed condonation fee for both Theory and Practical examinations separately (as applicable). |
| 3. | 64% to 50% | Below condonation | Student is NOT permitted to appear for current semester examinations. He/she has to mandatorily pay the condonation and examination fees in the current semester. He/she may appear for the lapsed papers in the next or subsequent semester. He/she may appear only for arrear examinations of previous semesters in the current semester provided they have recorded attendance above or within the condonation limits. |
| 4. | Below 50% | Re - do | Student is NOT permitted to appear for the examination. He/she shall re-do the semester in the next academic year (by rejoining) without proceeding to next semester and has to obtain prior permission from the Principal (through proper channel) to rejoin the programme. The re-do clause is bound by the conditions detailed in the respective Transitory Provision guidelines. |
